- 2. May apply to this award:
 - a. APES' members;
 - b. Graduate, MSc or PhD students (currently enrolled or who have concluded their studies during 2010 or 2011) from a national or international institution;
 - c. The submitted abstract must have been accepted by the Scientific Committee;
 - d. Be the first or main author of the abstract referred in c);
 - e. The author or any co-author cannot be a member of the Jury assigned for this award;
- 3. The paper submitted must be original and must not have been published yet;
- 4. The paper may be written in English or Portuguese;
- 5. Authors who want to apply to this award should express their interest by sending the full text of the paper, until 19th September 2011, to apes@ensp.unl.pt with the subject "12CNES Best Student Paper Prize";
