PFIZER Award for Best Poster

- 1. The Jury for the *Best Poster Award* is constituted by Cláudia Furtado (who presides), Henrique Martins, Joaquim Cristino, Luís Silva Miguel and Mónica Inês. The Jury deliberated the following:
- All posters accepted to the Conference will be considered for this award as long as they are exhibited in properly assigned place and as long as they follow the Conference rules for execution and presentation;
- 3. The criteria to select the best poster will be:
 - a. Scientific relevance for health economics;
 - b. Clearly stated objectives;
 - c. Originality;
 - d. Valid and suitable methods;
 - Relevance of the conclusions for decision makers and/or health management;
 - f. Overall evaluation;
- 4. Each item will be scored from 0 (worst) to 5 (best);
- 5. The author or any co-author cannot be a member of the Jury assigned for this award;
- 6. Prize money is 500€ and it may be split between more than one paper;

- 7. The winner(s) will be announced during the closing session of the 12th CNES, during which the prize will also be delivered;
- 8. Any author with an accepted poster may withdraw his poster from this prize. The author must inform the Scientific Committee of his/her decision until the beginning of the Conference;
- 9. The Jury's decisions will be taken by majority and cannot be appealed;
- 10. Any omissions to this regulation will be decided by Jury members.
